<p>Sharp round point (fine)</p> <p>Standard for blind stitch (FST 101) and very straight lockstitch seams in fine wovens and Schiffl embroidery</p>	<p>Regular round point</p> <p>Standard for lockstitch (FST 301); woven fabrics, artificial leather, coated woven fabrics</p>	<p>Round point with small ball point</p> <p>Standard for chain stitch; for fine, delicate knit fabrics, microfiber, woven fabrics, sewing buttons, embroidery and fine, soft clothing leather (FST 401 and 406)</p>	<p>Light ball point</p> <p>For general knit fabrics, woven fabrics made from cotton and/or synthetic sewing fabric.</p>

For elastic or loose-knit fabrics or sewing fabric with rubber or elastomer content

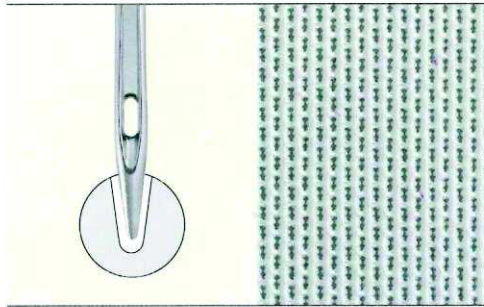

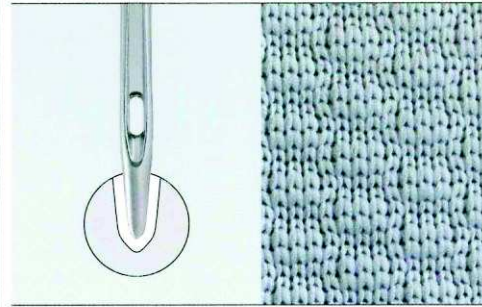
Heavy ball point

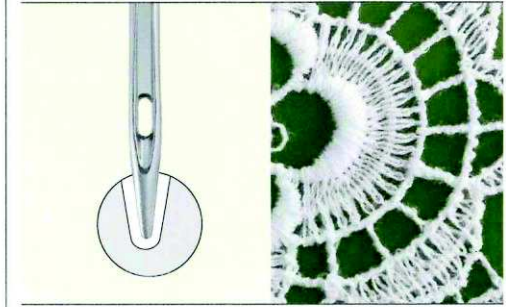


Special ball point
